What has Aaron been doing in Sweden?

I first started serving in Sweden as a youth pastor in an international church in 2007. Since then the Swedish Covenant Church as asked me to start a new church plant in Gothenburg, Sweden. In the summer of 2009 I was ordained in the ECC and in August 2011 the Swedish Covenant Church and the ECC started working together in this new multi-cultural church called Brunnen (The Well). The Swedish Covenant Church is covering the ministry costs for the church while the ECC is covering my salary and in-country costs as I live and serve as pastor for Brunnen. I live with my Swedish wife Stina (married June 2010) and our daughter Ruth (March 2012). We are recently thankful for moving into or new apartment, which is in the area of the church (November 2012).

The church-plant is a little over a year old now and already we have had: Communion/worship services, The Alpha Marriage Course, a Block-party, prayer & fasting days for Brunnsbo, started several new small-groups, been in conversation with the local authorities (police, school, landlords and social workers), working with the neighboring churches, started a language café which is every Monday to help immigrants learn Swedish, and seminars on spiritual gifts and discipleship.
