The medical clinic or "Clinica Emanuel" has served 12,127 patients and 8,341 additional patients through medical caravans!

Over 9,000 donations of food, supplies and medicines have been given to churches, institutions and individuals.

The clinic currently offers services of:

General and Family Medicine, Dentistry, Oral Surgery, Traumatology, Vascular Surgery, Obstetrics, Dermatology, Urology, Clinical Laboratory, Physical Therapy, Clinical Psychology, Pharmacy.

THE HOME CASA HOGAR SINCE 2017

The home has cared and fought for the rights of 80 children to date. There are currently 17 children being cared for in the Home ranging in age from 4 months to 17 years old.

In 2019 and 2020 respectively, two extension projects, the Prevention and Intervention programs, were created with the goal that the home will one day not be needed. These programs serve over 100 children and their families.
