The End-of-Year Initiative Focus is a Women's Artisan Workshop



Two out of three women in the area where we serve in Cayambe are victims of domestic abuse! For the last two years, the project in has been working with 15 women who are survivors of violent situations. It has been difficult for them to find financial independence from their abusers. Because of this, we hope to build a Women's Artisan Studio to help create indigenous jewelry for them to sell to break free from the cycle of violence. We hope to raise \$150,000 to create the workshop and complete the 2nd floor of the Home for At-Risk Children.
