The Clinic: Clinica Emanuel

*Completed 7 medical caravans
Attended 3,548 patients
Saw 1,695 patients in the clinic
Dentistry saw 1,057 patients
Through the laboratory 152 patients
Over 150,000 vitamins given
33 different illnesses treated
We will be adding gynecology, educational workshops and more specialties in 2018*

The Home: Casa Hogar Emanuel

*Opened in June 2017
Currently there are 11 children
1 child has been baptized and 2 now have a relationship with Christ.*

The children have been removed from situations of abuse, neglect, sex trafficking and prostitution
