Over 80 people came together from Covenant

churches in Thailand, Taiwan, Laos, Japan and the U.S. to talk about working together in Asia. This was the first time all the Asian Covenant denominations had ever come together, and it was fantastic. The delegation from Japan included 12 Japanese pastors

and 4 missionaries. Everyone came back with a renewed vision for the work of God in Asia.
