The Harvest is Plentiful, but the Workers are... Very Few

Could God be calling you to participate in the Harvest in France? Recently, we asked Pastor Thierry, our partner in France, "Why does France need missionaries?" Thierry passionately made the same plea for France as the man in Paul's vision for Macedonia in Acts 16. "France is no longer Christian," explained Thierry, "If the Lord calls you, come to France, come help us, come aid us because France needs Jesus Christ!"

To that invitation, our wholehearted response is "*Oui!*" France is historically Catholic, but today 1 out of 3 French is atheist, and only 1 percent of the population is evangelical. In Avignon, our partner church's discipleship and youth ministries are earnestly awaiting our arrival to help develop their mission.

We are both humbled by the needs yet compelled to go and serve in mission alongside the church in Avignon, France. We trust God's prompting that you, too, would feel called to respond, "*Oui!*" by sending us through your prayers and financial support.

Partner Raising

Reconnecting in partnership is a huge blessing! At a recent appointment, a friend shared plans to go on a mission trip to China, and we were mutually blessed by praying for each other's mission. We're encouraged by every contribution which counts to fund our preliminary expenses, ministry, insurance/benefits, salary, travel, housing, etc. during our two year assignment. Your giving also directly impacts when we will go. Our goal is to be fully funded, but as soon as donations meet the required 80% of our budget, we can set a departure date.

Our hope is to leave next summer in 2016 for our kids to start school in France. One way for you to help would be as a 50/50+ partner. This means 50 monthly donors at \$50 or more (less than \$2/day) would meet 50% of our fund! If you haven't met with us yet, would you consider partnering with us either prayerfully or financially? We will contact you to follow up this letter.
