We look at each other and know we are leaving our jobs and a predictable life in the US behind. But we have decided to follow that which we are passionate about - we both enjoy being with people and want to offer what we have - our languages and international/cultural experience to serve the Japanese Covenant Mission, reach out to the international community in Japan, and work with Portuguese and Spanish speakers.

We thank God for the opportunity to join the Covenant Church in Japan. Currently, it is made up of twenty-three churches and also a seminary, a camp, a Christian center, a daytime care center for the elderly and other projects that reach out to the communities through English classes, music and disaster relief efforts.

Our project uses music, teaching, preaching and discipleship in Spanish, Portuguese, and English to support existing projects of the local Covenant churches. We also hope to

help as needed with pastoral counseling, language groups (Italian, French, Japanese, Portuguese and Spanish), teaching English, and Covenant Relief, a disaster-relief organization.
