Reverend Karen E. Mosby-Avery currently serves as the Pastor of Pastoral Care and Administration at Second Baptist Church in Evanston. Prior to coming to Second Baptist Church, she served as the Director of Contextual Education at Chicago Theological Seminary in Hyde Park. Her work experience also includes 18 years of seeking to leverage the assets within an impoverished Chicago community, and within the broader Chicagoland community, on behalf of target populations that included low-income residents and disadvantaged youth and families. In her capacity as senior pastor of Good News Community Church, United Church of Christ, she collaborated with numerous organizations and agencies to identify resources to address core issues facing these populations. She received her Bachelor of Science degree in Journalism from Northwestern University in Evanston, Illinois and her Master of Divinity degree from Garrett-Evangelical Theological Seminary, also in Evanston.
