Arbey is so eager to dig into the Bible and has so many questions. - <u>What is your estimated date of departure?</u> We hope to be heading to Colombia in the fall. Julio will graduate in May and finish his internship over the summer! Our going is contingent upon whether or not we have raised all our support. We have to have 100% of our support for two years pledged/committed before we can buy our plane tickets!
- How much of your support have you raised? Praise God we are at 20%. We are so thankful for the people who have helped us get this far. We cannot do this without you! We continue to trust that we will be able to raise the remaining 80% in the next 4-5 months.
- 3. If I want to support you, do I need to give money now? Is it better to give a one time gift, or a monthly donation? One time gifts are great and so are monthly donations. If you choose do give monthly, you do not have to start your giving now. You can wait until we are closer to our departure, if you choose. However, we DO need to know that you are committed to give.
